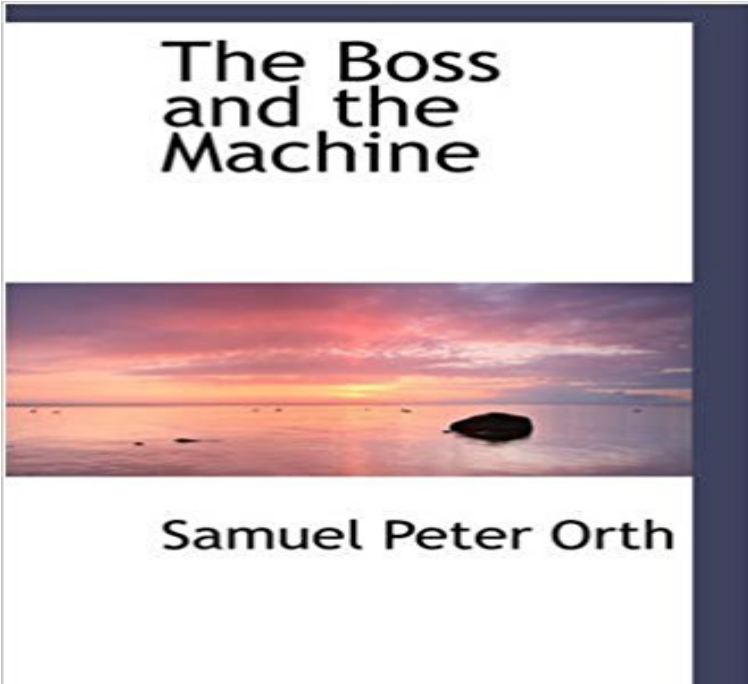


The Boss and the Machine
