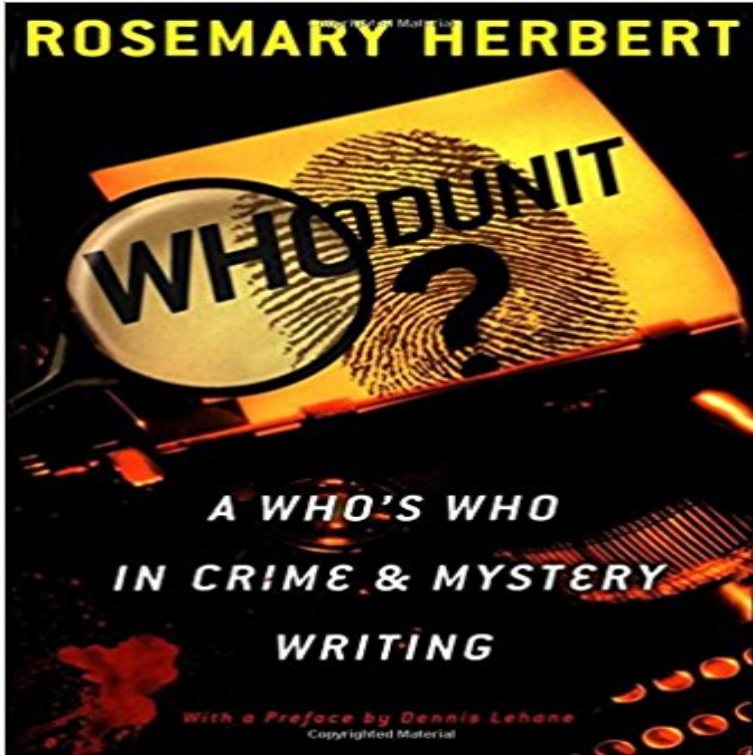


Whodunit?: A Whos Who in Crime & Mystery Writing
