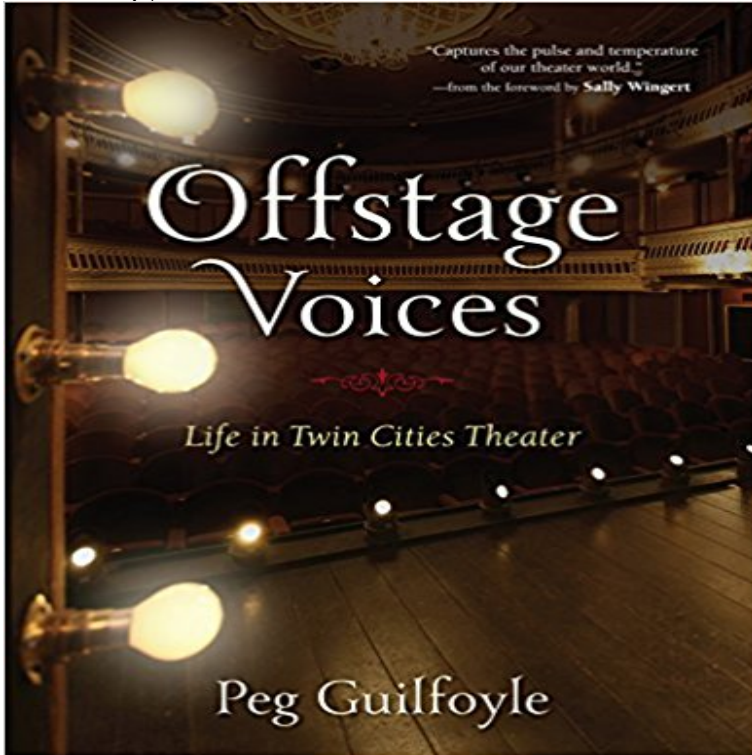


Offstage Voices: Life in Twin Cities Theater



In 1969, the Village Voice described Minneapolis as America's second theater city after New York. In the forty-plus years since, the theatrical offerings of Minneapolis and St. Paul have only grown everything from world-renowned venues to independent stages and innovative festivals and the Twin Cities hold a prominent place in the national theater scene today. In *Offstage Voices*, author Peg Guilfoyle provides an in-depth look at this vibrant world and offers fascinating insights into what it takes to put on a production, from first script to closing night, and what it takes to make a living in Twin Cities theater. Firsthand stories from practitioners of the art take you behind the scenes at a wide range of theaters, including the Guthrie, the Playwrights Center, Ten Thousand Things, Park Square Theatre, Mixed Blood, Penumbra, Theater Latte Da, Mu Performing Arts, the Minnesota Fringe Festival, and many more. Birds will continue to use them as shelter from weather and for protection from predators.
