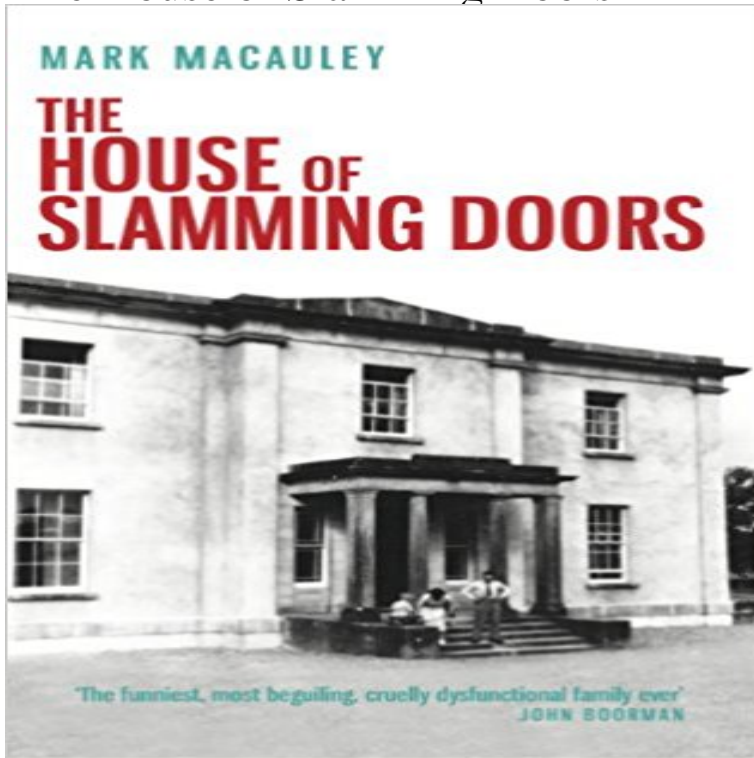


# The House of Slamming Doors
