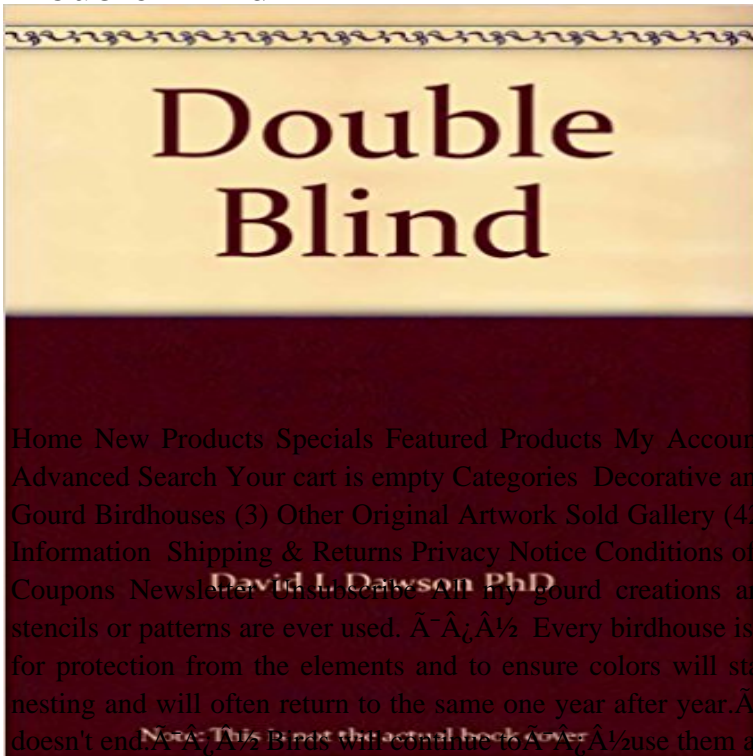


Double Blind
