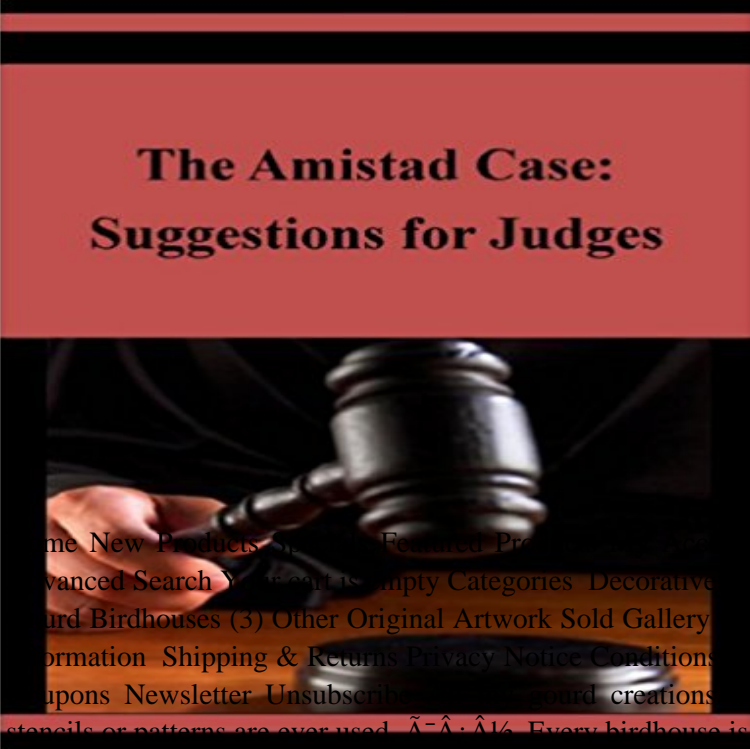


The Amistad Case: Suggestions for Judges
