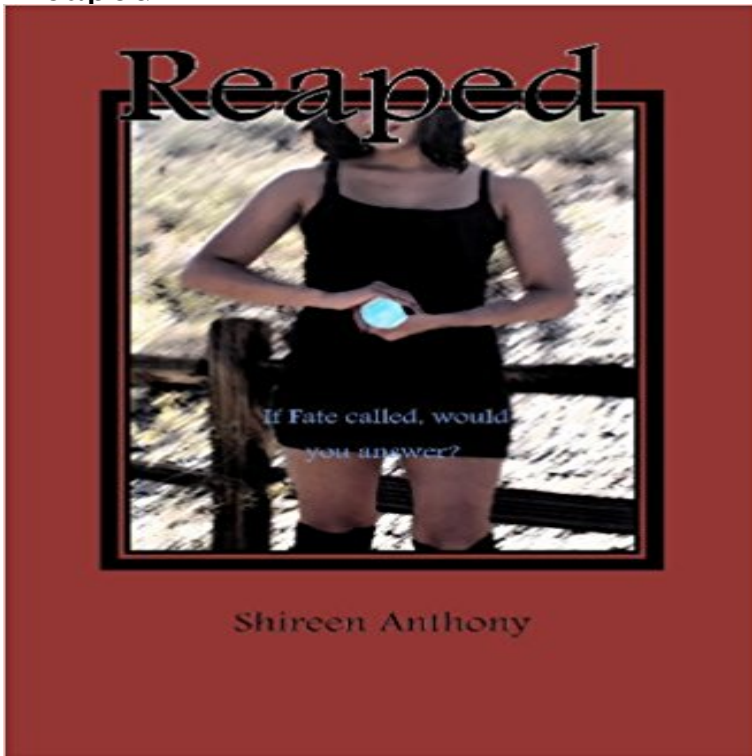


Reaped
